An Act extending the powers of Mt. Desert Railway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled as follows.

Sect. 1. The organization of Mt. Desert Railway, a corporation organized under the general Railway Laws of the State of Maine, and the renewal of its Charter by the Board of Railroad Commissioners, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. Said Mt. Desert Railway is hereby authorized to change its gauge to four feet eight and one half inches, and to construct and maintain its line and operate the same by electricity from some point on the seashore of Eden, in the village of Bar Harbor, to the villages of Seal Harbor and Northeast Harbor, in the town of Mt. Desert and may erect poles and wires for such method of operation.

 Sect. 3. - Said Mt. Desert Railway may purchase the stock, bonds, property and franchises of Green Mountain Railway, or may lease and operate said Green Mountain Railway, and said Green Mountain Railway is hereby authorized to sell or lease its franchises and property to said Mt. Desert Railway.

Sect. 4. Said Mt. Desert Railway is authorized to issue its stock and its bonds secured by a mortgage of its property and franchises, for the construction and equipment of its road, and for the purchasing or leasing of said Green Mountain Railway, in such sum as the stockholders of said Mt. Desert Railway may by vote declare to be necessary.

Sect. 5. This Act shall take effect when approved.
