Proceeding of Special Town Meeting held
 June 30, 1899.

State of Maine.

In accordance with the foregoing warrant duly posted and published the legal voters of the town of Eden met at the time and place designated in said warrant. Viz: - June 30th 1899 at five o'clock in the afternoon at Bar Harbor Municipal Court Room Bar Harbor and proceeded to act on the various articles as follows. - Meeting called to order by Clerk
 Article 1. Chose B. E. Clark Moderator. Sworn by Town Clerk.

Article 2 -

On Motion of Mr. Deacy, it was Voted: that the town make by-laws regulating vehicles used in said town as set forth in Article 2.

The following code of ordinances or by-laws were unanimously adopted.

By-Laws.

Article 1 No person owning or having charge or possession of any automobile or motor carriage so-called, or any vehicle propelled by machinery, shall run the same or cause or permit the same to be run through or upon any of the public streets of the town of Eden at a greater rate of speed than five miles an hour

Article 2 - No person shall run any automobile or motor carriage so-called or any vehicle propelled by machinery upon any public street of the town of Eden, until such person has satisfied the Municipal officers that he is competent to run and manage such vehicle without danger to others using the street and received a license for the purpose.

Article 3 - No person owning or having charge or possession of any automobile or motor carriage so-called, or any vehicle propelled by machinery, shall run the same or cause or permit the same to be run upon any public street of the town of Eden between the hours of ten A.M. and ten P.M.

Article 4 - No person owning or having charge or possession of any automobile or motor carriage so-called, or any vehicle

propelled by machinery shall run the same or cause or permit the same to be run at any time upon any of the following named streets of the town of Eden to wit: - Main Street, Schooner Head Road, Mount Desert Street, Cottage Street, West Street, Bradick Street, Eden Street, and the Bay Drive

Article 5. Any person found guilty upon complaint of violating either of the above ordinances shall for first offence pay for the use of said town of Eden a sum not exceeding twenty dollars for each offence.

Article 6. Nothing contained in any of the by-laws adopted to day shall be held to apply to any road motor or machine used by the Municipal Officers of the town for municipal purposes.

Notice of Condemnation.

The Bay Harbor Water Company hereby gives public notice that under and by virtue of the authority given to it by its charter to-wit: —

Private Acts of 1874, Chapter 449, and additions thereto and amendments thereto, particularly Private and Special Acts of 1895, Chapter 229. It has taken and proposes to take and use for the purpose of flowing, maintaining and storing the waters of Eagle Lake in the Town of Eden, Hancock County, State of Maine, a strip of land extending entirely around said lake, except such parts as are included in the deed from Mary H. Curran to said

Bay Harbor Water Company, dated May 8th, 1897 and recorded in the Hancock County Maine Registry of Deeds Vol. 313, Page 149, and excepting the part included in the condemnation proceedings of October 30th, 1895, whereby the Bay Harbor Water Company condemned and took a parcel of land near the outlet of said lake for the purpose of constructing a dam and other fixtures.

The strip of land hereby taken is bounded on one side by said lake and on the other side by a line of equal elevation extending around said lake ten inches above the top of the waste way of the present dam, said line is also marked as follows to-wit: — By two iron bolts set in the ledge on the shore of said Eagle Lake to-wit: —

One iron bolt bearing north sixty-six degrees West and distant two hundred thirty four and twenty-nine one hundredths feet from the center of the waste way and an iron bolt bearing south twenty-four degrees fifteen minutes East and distant three hundred seventy-one and seventh tenths feet from the middle of the waste way.

The top of said iron bolts is ten inches above the top

of the waste way and therefore marks the line of the outer limit of the strip hereby taken for flume. The first iron bolt above described is set in a ledge the top of which is thirty-eight one hundredths of a foot below the top of the waste way. The second iron bolt above described is set in a ledge the top of which is one-tenth of a foot below the top of the waste way.

The Bar Harbor Water Company takes said strip of land only for the purpose of raising, maintaining and storing the waters of Eagle Lake and yields and redemes to the several land owners all rights therein not inconsistent with said purpose.

The Bar Harbor Water Company disclaims any intention of increasing under this condemnation the height of its present dam or the height or other dimensions of its present waste way. The purpose of this condemnation is to acquire such rights (and no other) in the strip of land herein above described as will enable the Bar Harbor Water Company by means of its present dam or another dam of the same dimensions with a waste way of the same dimensions to flow and store the waters of Eagle Lake within and upon said strip of land above described.

The Bar Harbor Water Company has caused surveys to be made as required by section six of its charter and has caused an accurate plan to be filed in the town Clerk's Office of said town of Eden, and now gives notice to all persons affected as required and for all the purposes set forth in said charter. A copy of this notice is filed with and forms a part of said plan.

Notice of the Inland Fisheries and Game for the protection of the inland game of the Towns of Eden, Mt. Desert and Tremont.

State of Maine.
Public Notice.

In conformity with the provisions of Chapter Forty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and upon the petition of five or more citizens of the State, and deeming it for the best interest of the State, the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game after due notice to all persons interested in the subject-matter of said petition, and public hearing thereon in the locality to be affected, and deeming it necessary and proper for the protection and preservation of the inland game of the State, hereby adopt the following needful Rules and Regulations relating to the times and places in which and the circumstances under which inland game may be taken in the towns of Eden, Mt. Desert and Tremont.

Rules and Regulations.

The hunting of, catching, chasing or killing any deer in either of the towns of Eden, Mt. Desert or Tremont is hereby absolutely forbidden and made unlawful for a term of two years from October 2nd. A.D. 1899.

Section 36, Chapter 42, of the Public Laws of 1899.

Whoever takes, catches, kills or destroys any inland game in any manner or at any time, in violation of any of the rules and regulations of the Commissioners of inland fisheries and

and game, made and promulgated in conformity with the provisions of this chapter shall be punished in the same manner and to the same extent as is provided for by the law for the illegal taking, catching, killing or destroying any such inland game.

Section. 37- Any person who willfully mutilates, defaces or destroys any notice, rule or regulation of the Commissioner of inland fisheries and game, posted in conformity with the provisions of this act, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, to be recovered by complaint or indictment: one half of said fine shall be paid to the prosecutor.
