Drain Across Land of Mrs B Rice
Munraunum.

For the purpose of draining Bridge Street and vicinity, Bar Harbor, Maine, the town officers of the town of Eden have begun the construction of a drain leading in part across property formerly of Mrs B. Rice. This is being done with the distinct understanding that there has been no condemnation or dedication of the land for the purpose and that nothing has been or is being done that gives to the town any property rights in said land or imposes any burden or servitude upon the land. It is further understood that no future maintenance of such drain or repairs upon or acquiescence therein shall constitute a condemnation or dedication or give any property rights. Nor shall any prescriptive rights be claimed as said drain is constructed and will be maintained by virtue of a revocable license from the trustees of said estate. Nothing herein shall prevent the town from condemning land for such drain at any time in the future, but in case of such condemnation damages shall be assessed as unaffected by the existence of the drain now under construction.

To George P. Billings, a constable of
the Town of Eden, Greeting.

In the name of the state of Maine
you are hereby required to notify and warn
the inhabitants of said Town of Eden, qualified
to vote in town affairs, to meet at Police Station
hall, Bar Harbor in the Town of Eden, on Thursday
the twenty-ninth day of March A. D. 1900 at
ten o'clock A. M. to act on the following article
to wit:-

Article 1. To choose a moderator to preside
at said meeting.

Article 2. To see if the town will vote to
accept a sewer as laid out by the selectmen
beginning in the Forest Street branch
where said branch crosses the Eagle
Lake road: thence running in a
general south westerly direction along
said Eagle Lake Road about fifteen
hundred and twenty five feet to a
point opposite the Rebo Valley Club house.

Article 3. To see if the town will raise a
sum of money to construct the sewer
mentioned in the preceding article, or
to hire a sum of money for the purpose
and issue its negotiable notes or notes
therefor.

Article 4. To see if the town will vote
to hire a sum of money sufficient to defray
the liabilities incurred and to be incurred
in anticipation of uncollected taxes. and to
issue its negotiable note or notes therefor
and to determine the terms and conditions of such note or
notes and authorize the selectmen to execute and negotiate the same.

Article 5. To see if the town will provide a sewer for Seth Hopkins, E. H. Young and others on a private way leading along Eddy Brook.

Article 6. To see if the town will vote to abolish the existing town ordinance prohibiting or regulating the use of automobiles in said town, and to pass a new ordinance or ordinances to regulate the same.

Proceedings of Special Town meeting.

March 29th. 1900.

In accordance with the foregoing warrant duly posted and published, the legal voters of the Town of Eden met at the time and place designated in said warrant at the Police Station Hall and
Voted to adjourn to the Y. A. R. Hall, on March 29th 1900 and proceeded to act on the various articles, as follows.

Article 1. Chose B. E. Whitney moderator and he was duly sworn.

Article 2. Voted that the sewer as mentioned and described in Art. 2 and laid out by the Selectmen be accepted. ~~also~~

Article 3: Voted: To raise \$2200. to construct the sewer as referred to in Article 2.

Article 4. Voted that the town hire the sum of twenty thousand dollars for a time not exceeding five months.
Five thousand dollars coming due Aug. 1. 1900.
Ten thousand dollars coming due Aug. 15. 1900.
and Five thousand dollars coming due Sept. 1. 1900.
and that the selectmen be authorized to issue the town's negotiable notes for said sums of twenty thousand dollars.

Article 5: Voted: That the Supt. of sewers be requested to bring in a report on this sewer at the next annual meeting.

Article 6. Voted: To abolish the ordinance relating to automobiles.

The following ordinance was adopted.

No automobile carriage, whether propelled by steam,

electricity, gasoline or other motive power, shall be driven more than seven miles per hour in any of the streets in the Town of Eden, and said carriage shall not be used after sunset without suitable lights.

Any person who has charge of an automobile carriage in the streets of Eden whenever he sees that it is about to frighten a horse shall immediately shut off his power and stop the same and take all reasonable and proper precautions against the frightening of horses while the same are in use.

Whoever violates this town ordinance shall pay a fine not exceeding Ten dollars and legal costs, and in default of payment of such fine and costs may be imprisoned thirty days in the county jail at Ellsworth.

Complaints for the violation of this ordinance may be made to the judge or recorder of the Bar Harbor Municipal Court or before any trial justice in the County of Hancock, but all warrants shall be returned to the Court or Recorder as other Criminal cases are, who shall hear, try and furnish for violation of this act.

No person shall use an automobile carriage until he has written permit from the Selectmen of Eden.
