License to A. E. Cornes and Frank M. Cornes
to build a wharf into the tide waters of Bas Harbor

Whereas, by section 10. of an act of Congress, approved March 3, 1899, entitled, "An act making appropriations for the construction, repair and preservation of certain public works, on rivers and harbors, and for other purposes," It is provided that it shall not be lawful to build or commence the building of any wharf, pier, dolphin, boom, weir, breakwater, bulkhead, jetty or other structures in any port, roadstead, haven, harbor canal, navigable river, or other water of the United States outside established harbor lines, or where no harbor lines have been established, except on plans recommended by the Chief of Engineers and authorized by the Secretary of War; and it shall not be lawful to excavate or fill, or in any manner to alter or modify the course, location, condition or capacity, of any port roadstead, haven, harbor, canal, lake, harbor of refuge or inclosure within the limits of any break water, or of the channel of any navigable water of the United States, unless the work has been recommended by the Chief of Engineers and authorized by the Secretary of War prior to beginning the same.

And whereas, Frank M. Cornes and Alfred E. Cornes both of Bas Harbor Maine, co-partners doing business at said Bas Harbor under the firm name and style of Cornes Brothers, have applied to the Secretary of War for permission to build and maintain a wharf in navigable waters at Bas Harbor, Maine, as shown on the attached plans; which plans have been recommended by the Chief of Engineers.

Now therefore: This is to certify that the Secretary of War hereby gives unto said Cornes Brothers permission to build and maintain a wharf in navigable waters at said place, as shown on said plans, subject to the

following conditions,

That the work herein permitted to be done shall be subject to the supervision and approval of the Engineer Officer of the United States Army in charge of the locality.
