Pursuant to the above petition and notice, both of which are expressly referred to and made a part of this return, we, the undersigned, municipal officers of the Town of Eden, Hancock County, State of Maine, having given written notice of our intentions by posting up notices, of which the foregoing is a true copy, in two public places in the said town of Eden and in the vicinity of said way, to wit, one on a telegraph pole at the junction of School Street and a private way known as Wescott Avenue, and one in the office of the selectmen of said Town of Eden, said notices having been posted on February 18th, A. D. 1910 being at least seven days prior to time of laying out said way, met and at time and place specified in said notice, to wit, at the office of the Selectmen of said Town of Eden, on Friday, February 25, A. D. 1910, at ten o'clock in the forenoon and for the purpose therein specified, and at said meeting we heard the petitioners and all other persons interested, and after hearing and fully understanding the matter, we determined to lay out a town way for the use of said town as prayed for by said petition and we accordingly laid out said way, as a town way, substantially following the route described in said petition and specifically described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at a point in west line of School Street said point being one hundred and twenty (120) feet northerly of the northeast corner of school house lot; thence North $85^{\circ} 45'$ West three hundred and twenty-three and five tenths (323.5) feet more or less to the east line of land formerly of John Hopkins's side above described line being the southerly side line of said way and said way is to be sixteen and five tenths (16.5) feet wide in every part.

We also determined that no damages are sustained by any person or persons by the laying out of said way, and we therefore award no land damages.
