Beginning at a piece of iron pipe driven in the ground in the easterly side line of Main Street, one hundred and fifty (150) feet northerly of another piece of iron pipe driven in the ground at the intersection of the north line of Oliver Street with the said east line of Main Street; thence running south $85^{\circ} 20'$ East five hundred and twenty two and seventy five hundredths (322.75) feet to another piece of iron pipe driven in the ground at the intersection of the line herein above described and the west side line of Snow Street. The way shall be thirty (30) feet wide and

the above described line is the southerly side thereof.

We also determined that no damages are sustained by any persons or persons by the laying out of said way, and we therefore award no land damages.

Collectors Return To Town Clerk of Tax Sales.
- State of Maine -

To W. H. Sherman, Clerk of the Town of Eden, to the County of Hancock and State of Maine:

Pursuant to law I caused the taxes assessed on the real estate of non-resident owners described herein situated in the town of Eden, for the year 1909, to be advertised according to law by advertising in the Bar Harbor Record a newspaper published in said county, three weeks successively, the first publication being on the twenty second day of December 1909, and at least six weeks before the day of sale; and caused the tax assessed on the real estate of resident owners, described herein, situated in the town of Eden, for the year 1909, to be advertised according to law by posting notices as required by law at the following places, at the Post Office at Bar Harbor, the Post Office at Hulls Cove, the Post Office at Salsbury Cove, the Post Office at Eden, the Post Office at West Eden, at the Post at Indian Point, being public and conspicuous places in said town, at least six weeks before the day of sale, to wit, on the twenty fourth day of December 1909; I also, at least ten days before the day of sale, to wit, on the nineteenth day of January 1910, gave to each resident owner of said lands, or the occupant thereof, if any in hand, or left at his last, and usual place of abode, and sent by mail to the last and usual address of each non-resident owner of said land, whose address was known to me, written notice of the time and place of said sale, and the amount of taxes due, in the manner provided by law.

And afterwards on the first Monday of February, 1910, at the Casino in Bar Harbor in said Eden, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, being the time and place of sale, I proceeded to sell according to the tenor of the advertisements the estates upon which the taxes so assessed remained unpaid to the persons and for the sums set forth in the schedules forming a part of this return, the same having been struck off to the said persons, they being the highest bidders therefor, and it being necessary to sell said amount

of real estate so taxed and advertised as aforesaid and no person offering to pay said taxes and charges for a smaller fractional part of said land at a public auction legally notified as hereinbefore set forth and held at the Casino in Bar Harbor, in said Eden, (being the place where the last proceeding Annual Town Meeting was held) on the first Monday in February, A.D. 1910. at nine o'clock a.m. when and where I, the said Collector, exposed said property for sale and offered to sell such fractional parts thereof as were necessary to pay such taxes and charges and could not obtain bids for any smaller fractional parts thereof than those set forth in the said schedule; and I have made and executed deeds of the several parcels sold to the several persons entitled thereto, and placed them on file in the Town Treasurer's office, to be disposed of as the law requires; and lodged my certificate of said tax sales with the Town Treasurer within thirty days after the day of sale.

Agreement for Disposal Garbage, Inhabitants of Eden.
Frank Spratt.

Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into this eighteenth day of April A.D. 1910 by and between Frank Spratt of Eden, Hancock County, Maine, party of the first part, and the Inhabitants of the Town of Eden, a Municipal Corporation in said County of Hancock, party of the second part.

Witnesseth that whereas there is pending in the Supreme Judicial Court in Equity for said County of Hancock a suit in which said Spratt et al. are plaintiff and said Inhabitants of Eden, the Board of Health et al. are defendants and which said suit is in regard to the disposal of garbage in said Town of Eden, set for hearing on April 19th. A.D. 1910, and

Whereas there is under consideration the proposition of establishing an incinerating plant in said Town of Eden, a special Town meeting to determine the adoption or rejection of same is to be held in said Eden, July twenty 1910, now therefore, it is agreed as follows:

1. That said suit be continued until after said Town meeting to be held July twenty, 1910 with the understanding that if the Town decides at that meeting to build an incinerating plant said suit shall be dismissed. If said Town does not vote to build said incinerating plant said case to be heard at once by the Court.

2. It is agreed by the parties hereto that until after said meeting of July 20, 1910 and if after that date the Town fails to vote to erect an incinerating plant until after final decision of the Court in said suit that said Spratt will destroy and dispose of the garbage of said Town of Eden in the same manner and under the same conditions as set forth in agreement entered into by and between him and the said Inhabitants of the Town of Eden, which agreement is dated March 18, 1905, except that

his compensation for destroying and disposing of the garbage shall be as follows; to wit:

For the month of May 1910	the sum of	* 234.00
For the month of June 1910		* 330.00
For the month of July 1910		* 436.00

And the said party of the second part hereby agrees that said Spratt shall have the disposal of the garbage for said town for said period of three months and that it will pay him therefor the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) in payments as above set forth.

For such further time as the Board of Health of said Eden may desire, beginning August 1, 1910 and pending either the establishing of an incinerating plant if the town votes at said meeting so to do, or if it does not vote to establish said plant and pending the final decision of the court in said suit above referred to said Spratt agrees to dispose of said garbage under the same conditions upon the following terms to wit:

For the month of August	* 408.00
For the month of September	* 204.00
For the month of October	* 204.00
For the month of November	* 204.00

And for each month thereafter until the first day of April 1911 at the rate of * 136.00 per month.

3. Said Spratt agrees to give a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of said agreement in the sum of * 2000.00.
