Primary Election Warrant

To the Legal Voters of the Town of Eden.

You are hereby notified that a Primary Election in this town of all political parties, entitled by law to nominate candidates for the Special Election, will be held at the Casino on Monday July 28th, next for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices to be voted for at the election to be held on the Second Monday in September next, viz:

Representative to Congress.

The polls will be open at twelve o'clock noon and continue open until nine o'clock in the afternoon when they will close.

Voters not enrolled as members of a political party entitled to nominate candidates will not be permitted to vote. But voters entitled to enrollment may cause themselves to be enrolled at the polling places during the Primary Election on taking and subscribing the oath required by law.

The selectmen hereby give notice that they will be in session at the office of the Selectmen, Bar Harbor, in said town of Eden, on Friday and Saturday, the 19th and 20th days of July, from nine o'clock in the forenoon till five o'clock in the afternoon of each day for the purpose of hearing and deciding upon the applications of those claiming the right to vote in said town. And that no names will be received later than five o'clock in the afternoon of the regular day next preceding the day of election and that no names will be received on the day of election except such as were upon the list of the previous election and have been inadvertently omitted by the Selectmen.

Began at Iron Bolt set in large boulder at head
of Otter Creek, so called.

From which a spruce tree, spotted, bears South 47°

South $73^{\circ}30'$ East 70.5 feet

North $22^{\circ}15'$ East 53.6 feet
